

Baltic sailing cruise and maritime festival visit

Ocean Youth Trust South has places available on a very special voyage this year. As the name implies, our primary focus is on youth voyages, but this is a rare opportunity for adults to sail with us – this experience is open to anyone aged 18+, with no upper age limit.

Kiel, Germany to Gdynia, Poland
28th June to 4th July - £490 per person ex travel

Starting in Kiel, you could enjoy a few days' sailing in the beautiful Baltic, arriving in Gdynia, in Poland in time to join a magnificent maritime festival. Almost 100 vessels are already booked to take part, including nineteen traditional square-rigged sailing vessels, all open to the public.

The last similar event in Poland attracted over 2 million visitors, but as crew members on board our 72-foot ketch, *John Laing*, your time in Gdynia will be spent at the heart of the festival, with free access to events and activities.



After two days at the festival, you will be handing the vessel over to a crew of young people aged 15-25 for a race to St Petersburg.

No sailing experience is necessary, though keen and competent sailors are always welcome! You will be an active crew member on board, not just a passenger. Full training is included in the package.

OYT South is a charity which normally uses adventure under sail as a personal development opportunity for young people aged 12-25, the majority from disadvantaged backgrounds. The price of your holiday helps provide places on other voyages for young people who cannot otherwise afford to sail.
